1. Do you support the efforts of Welcoming Michigan? Why? Why Not?

No. While I appreciate attempts to offer a welcoming environment to immigrants seeking to assimilate as American citizens, Welcoming Michigan has proven to be a politically-motivated initiative that promotes division not assimilation. It is clear from their communications that they are attempting to “fundamentally transform America” using our own sympathies and appreciation for immigrants against us.

2. Do you support the current U.S. Refugee Resettlement Program? Why? Why Not?

No. The process features the United Nations as a key decision maker as to who enters our country and who does not. The current process abrogates the first responsibility of government, namely to secure the rights of our citizens. I introduced SCR 22 in an attempt to keep Governor Snyder’s finger on the “pause button” until the security provisions in the process could be enhanced. There are other ways to secure refugees from harm that do not involve increased risk to American citizens.

3. Do you support making Michigan a Sanctuary State? Why? Why Not?

No. A fundamental tenet of our social compact as citizens of the United States is the rule of law. The concept of a sanctuary city or sanctuary state is antithetical to this tenet.

4. Having taken the oath of office, how would you balance diversity and assimilation?

We are called the United States of America not because we all are the same race or country of origin but rather because we all hold the same truths to be self-evident. Those truths are defined in our Declaration of Independence and secured via the provisions of our U.S. Constitution. The goal of immigration policy should be assimilation into a culture that respects and adheres to these truths.

5. Name examples of Shariah compatibility/incompatibility with the U.S. Constitution.

Our U.S. Constitution was derived in part from our Declaration of Independence which states that we are ALL created equal. Under Shariah, there are 3 classes of citizens – male Muslims, female Muslims, and Kafir.

Article VI of the U.S. Constitution states that the Constitution is the Supreme Law of the land. Shariah Law operates as an independent legal authority.

The First Amendment of the Constitution states that we all have Freedom of Religion and Freedom of Speech. Shariah Law punishes those who choose to leave Islam or insult Mohammed.
